



Back in the days when diseases were considered curse or result of sin, people prayed to God for His



Malala Yousafzai was born on 12th July 1997 in the Swat Valley region of Pakistan. She grew up with her two younger brothers in the city of Mingora. She had a happy childhood. Her father, Ziauddin was a teacher and ran a school for girls where she could attend. Malala was a bright girl and dreamt of becoming a teacher, a politician or a doctor one day.

At the young age of 11, Malala began advocating for girls' education. She spoke out against the Taliban saying "How dare the


Taliban take away my right to education?" Her speech was covered by Newspaper and TV channels. The Talibans were strict Muslims who were against women going for work or having the right to vote. They demanded that all girls' school be shut down. About this time, Malala's father was approached by the BBC. They wanted a female student to write about her life under Taliban rules, so Malala began writing a blog called "Diary of a Pakistan School Girl".

The Taliban were not happy about this and Malala received many death threats. On October 9, 2012, Malala was returning home from school in the school bus, a man boarded the bus and shot Malala; the bullet stuck Malala's head, but luckily, she survived. After many surgeries, she regained her normal self and went back to school six month later after the attack.

On her sixteenth birthday, Malala gave a speech to the United Nations about wanting all girls to go to school and be educated, stating "Invest in books, not bullets". She also spoke about opportunity and peace for all. Later, Malala's Autobiography 'I am Malala': The story of a girl, who stood up for education and was shot by the Taliban was published in October 2013.

On 10^{th} October 2014 Malala become the youngest person to receive the Nobel prize for Peace.



(TERESA WIPES HER HAND ON HER DRESS AND LEANS FORWARD TO WHISPER IN HIS EARS)


'And she has never been found!'

TUBERCULOSIS NEEDS YOUR ATTENTION

Tuberculosis (TB) is one of the top 10 cause of death worldwide and leading cause of death from a single infectious agent (mycobacterium tuberculosis). TB has devastating impact on public health and economy of our country. Out of 1.4 million TB deaths worldwide 400,000 TB cases are reported from India. The herculean task of eliminating TB has been there for 50 years and was called

National Tuberculosis Elimination Programme previously known as RNTCP.

Our Prime Minister Shri. Narendra Modi has accelerated the program to eliminate it by 2025.

Challenges: The obstacles of reaching the goals were there for so long like delay in diagnosis and treatment. Another adverse reason is poor drug compliance that leads to drug resistant to that further leads to burden in our country.

Responsibilities: As a health professional we should break the stigma, counsel them on drug compliance and we should be an advocate to decentralize the treatment. Moreover, we should spread awareness of TB.

ACCIDENTAL INVENTIONS IN THE FIELD OF MEDICINE

1. Penicillin

Penicillin was first discovered by alexander Fleming in 1928. It was accidental discovery that saved millions of lives in the coming years. Alexander discovered mould grown in the petri dish after he returned from the vacation. He noted that there was some kind of defence mechanism that destroyed the bacteria in the petri dish. It became the mostly used drug in World War 2 with the help of Howard Florey and Ernst Chain.

2. Quinine

It began to be used in treatment of Malaria from 1600. It was called as Sacred Bark. The tree is named after the Countess of Chinchon from Peru. In 1630 she was very sick with malaria and had a high fever. Her doctor gave her a drink made from cinchona and she got better. People in Europe heard about this medicine and then came to the rainforest to collect the plant. It was first called quinine in 1820 by two French scientists, Mr Pelletier and Mr Caventou, who made the first modern medicine from the tree bark.

3. X ray

X ray was accidentally discovered in 1895 by Wilhelm roentgen, professor of physics. that time he was studying cathode rays. He was surprised when an incandescent green light escaped and projected on fluorescent screen from his cathode tube that was covered in heavy black paper. He studied that this ray could pass through most of the substance and leave a shadow of impenetrable objects.

4. Small pox vaccine

Edward Jenner heard that a diary girl says, "I shall never have small pox, for I have had cowpox". Jenner proposed a safer approach to small pox vaccine. Jenner harvested pustule from young dairy maid Sarah Nelmes and inoculated his gardener's eight-year-old son. he inoculated the boy with small pox later but he didn't develop small pox.

5. Movement of ions

Luigi Galvani discovered that the muscles of dead frogs' legs twitched when struck by an electrical spark. He accidentally touched a nerve with a scalpel. It was the idea that signal that moved from nerve to nerve and nerve to muscle was by electricity- the influx and efflux of charged ions

- Chopped garlic 2 tbsp
- Soy sauce 1 tbsp
- Honey 2 tbsp
- Brown sugar − 2 tsp

- Butter ½ cup
- Spring onion to garnish

Method of preparation:

- Wash the chicken thoroughly. To the chicken, add corn flour, maida, salt, egg, water and mix till the chicken is coated with the batter.
- Heat oil in a pan and deep fry the chicken to a golden-brown color
- In another pan, add oil, chopped garlic and saute till it turns light brown
- Add water, soy sauce, honey and brown sugar and mix till they combine evenly
- Reduce the flame to low, add butter and let it melt slowly and blend it with the other ingredients to form a smooth sauce.
- Garnish it with chopped spring onion and serve it hot.

RASAMALAI RECIPE

Rasamalai is a popular and delicious Bengali sweet where lip-smacking cottage cheese balls are soaked in lusciously thick, sweetened milk

Servings -8 to 10

Preparation - 5min

Cooking – 20min

Ingredients:

- Nestle milkmaid ½ tin
- Nestle toned milk 4 cups(600ml)
- Well mashed paneer 300gm
- Saffron 8 to 10 strands
- Cardamom powder − ½ tsp
- Pistachios 10 to 20 (chopped)
- Water 1L
- Sugar -2 cups(300gm)

Method of preparation:

- Mash paneer with hand for at least 6 minutes to make smooth dough.
- Alongside take a pan add sugar and water together and bring to boil to make syrup for cooking rasamalai.
- Make small balls of panner dough and flatten, add into boiling sugar syrup, cover and cook for 10 minutes on medium heat. Remove and keep aside to cool.
- Take out the rasagullas from sugar syrup squeeze gently to remove the sugar syrup
- In another pan pour into nestle toned milk and nestle milkmaid, bring to boil and reduce to half. Turn of the flame, add saffron and cardamom powder and mix well. Allow to cool.
- Now put rasagullas into saffron mixture
- Garnished with chopped pistachios and serve chilled.
